



Michael Fugler Re-Joins the St. Bernard Project at FSXinterlinked Conference & Produces a Video Reaching Out for Community Support

New Orleans, LA, March 24, 2015, Michael Fugler re-joins the St. Bernard Project (SBP) at the FSXinterlinked Investment Conference at The Ritz Carlton in New Orleans, Louisiana, to help rebuild homes destroyed in Hurricane Katrina and produces a video reaching out for community support.

Mr. Fugler joined Delray Wannamacher, Executive Director of FSXinterlinked, Judy Ensweiler, former FSX Executive Director, and a group of FSX members who volunteered to help the families who own homes they cannot afford to rebuild.

Mr. Fugler, a native of Louisiana, stated, "It is hard to believe that ten years after Hurricane Katrina there are still hundreds of homes that are in disrepair and ruin. St. Bernard Project has rebuilt over 560 homes, all with the help of volunteers. I find it personally rewarding to be able to give back to this community and encourage others to look into the program."

Mr. Fugler, the Host for interlinkedTV while working as a volunteer on the SBP produced a community video appeal which is aired on interlinkedTV, <http://interlinked.com/tv/2015/03/18/fsxinterlinked-volunteers-at-st-bernard-project>, reminding the viewers that although Katrina happened a number of years ago, the devastation and clean up is still ongoing and requires a continuous flow of volunteers to finish what was started.

The organization of course can use some financial support but most importantly they need physical support in the form of people to do manual labor, even if only for a day. You

would be amazed how much work can get done with a dedicated, focused group in one day.”

The St. Bernard Project’s Rebuilding Program in New Orleans rebuilds homes for senior citizens, people with disabilities and families with children who can not afford to have their homes rebuilt by contractors. For clients who can afford supplies, the St. Bernard Project provides supervised volunteer labor. For clients who can not afford supplies, the St. Bernard Project buys the supplies and provides the labor. A typical rebuild project takes approximately 6-12 weeks of volunteer labor and uses approximately \$30,000 worth of building supplies.
