

Michael Fugler Introduces ELSA's Code of Practice to The International Life Settlements Conference



London, United Kingdom / PRBuzz / May 16, 2011 - - Michael Fugler, Deputy Chairman of the European Life Settlement Association (ELSA), spoke at Deal Flow Media's International Life Settlements Conference 2011 in London, United Kingdom, May 11-12, 2011 where he introduced ELSA's Code of Practice.

Michael Fugler, from Welcome Life Financial Group, participated in a lively discussion of Industry Best Practices at The International Life Settlements Conference. He participated on a panel which explored whether new guidelines on best practices developed by trade groups would bring confidence to the Life Settlement market. The panel was one of the highlights of the event. Joining Mr. Fugler was, ZOHAR ELHANANI, Legacy Benefits; CHRISTIAN SEIDL, BVZL; ROBIN WILLI, Rigi Capital Partners.

The panel noted that the Institutional Life Markets Association ("ILMA") drafted a set of best practices in the US to guide providers in 2007, that the Major Life Expectancy Providers (LEPrs) had recently developed its own guidelines and the Life Insurance Settlement Association ("LISA") in the US was working on developing its own Best Practices, including most if not all industry participants. Michael Fugler demonstrated that the European Life Settlement Association had lead the way in Europe for investor protection with its new Code of Practice.

The conference focused on:

Reviewing two years after the worldwide recession hit whether recovery is on the way for Life Settlements as investors and private equity firms begin once again to enter the Life Settlement market. Large institutional investors with European connections are buying portfolios and setting up for the long term by taking advantage of the many distressed portfolios available and preparing for the future.

Mr. Fugler stated, "The International Life Settlements Conference provided a vibrant forum for discussion and debate about what type of assets these new market participants are interested in and what their plans are for the long term for entering into the market."

Mr. Fugler further stated, "With ELSA stepping up and producing serious industry standards for investor protection I don't believe today that there are sufficient problems

in the Life Settlement business that require a rush to judgment by regulators and legislators and their apparent cooperative spirit seems to be pointing to a more measured approach and a better long term solution. ELSA's goal is to make sure the participants are properly licensed and educated, the product designs are suitable, proper due diligence is done, consumer privacy is protected, the market has security, transparency and some form of fiduciary responsibility is practiced by its participants."
