

ESCAMBIA COUNTY CITIZENS ENVIRONMENTAL COMMITTEE NAMES MICHAEL ROY FUGLER AS CHAIRMAN, DR. LESLIE H. DAVIS AS VICE CHAIRMAN

PENSACOLA, FLORIDA — DECEMBER 30, 2003— Michael Roy Fugler, Perdido Key, and Dr. Leslie H. Davis, Pensacola, were appointed Chairman and Vice-Chairman, respectively, of the Escambia County Citizens Environmental Committee (CEC), effective January 1, 2004.



Mr. Fugler, was appointed a member of the CEC in June 2002 by County Commissioner Tom Banjanin District 4, and was elected Vice Chairman in January 2003. Very active in local affairs, Mr. Fugler is President of Palacio at Perdido Owners' Association, a member of the Perdido Key Chamber of Commerce, Perdido Key Association and one of the founders of the Perdido Key Leadership Group. He's resided in the Gulf of Mexico region his entire life. "We live in a particularly environmentally sensitive area, and I'm honored to take on the important job of helping to bring solutions that balance the needs of Escambia County with the preservation of our delicate ecosystems."

Dr. Davis, a doctor of veterinary medicine with the Scenic Hills Veterinary Hospital, is a Pensacola native and CEC member since April 2003.

About Michael Roy Fugler


Michael Roy Fugler is Chairman of US EURO Securities, Inc., and concentrating on growing the company into an integral part of the international investment community.
